## NOMINATION FORM FOR ROYAL SOCIETY OF NEW SOUTH WALES BICENTENNIAL EARLY CAREER RESEARCH AND SERVICE CITATION

Three citations plus a complimentary year of Associate Membership of the Society, are awarded each year to recognise outstanding contributions to research and service to the academic and wider community. Applicants must on 1 January of the year of nomination be no more than 5 years after the award of their PhD or equivalent by a university or other research institution in NSW or the ACT.

Winners will be expected to deliver a short presentation of their work at a general meeting of the Society in February or later of the year following that in which the award was made, and also submit a paper to the Journal and Proceedings of the Royal Society of New South Wales.

Council established these Early Career Citations in 2023 to commemorate the Society's Bicentenary.

Nominations open on 1 July each year and close on 30 September. Awardees are announced by the end of that calendar year with formal presentations of their Awards in the following year. All nominations require a nominator and a seconder who need not be Members of the Society. Recipients may be resident in NSW or elsewhere and must be no more than 5 years from the award of their PhD or equivalent on 1 January of the year of nomination. All Royal Society of New South Wales awards are assessed relative to opportunity.

Each nomination must comply with the conditions of award and will consist of a completed nomination form together with supporting documentation as specified on the form.

To submit a Nomination, please add a 100 word summary, the required curriculum vitae, and two letters of nomination and support. Please combine the components into a single PDF and email to <a href="mailto:awards-nominations@royalsoc.org.au">awards-nominations@royalsoc.org.au</a> by 30 September of the year of nomination.
