This alphabetical bibliography was assembled by an RSNSW Councillor, Dr Davina Jackson, using a [chronological listing](#) compiled by the Editor of the *RSNSW Journal and Proceedings*, Emeritus Professor Robert Marks. Many entries are linked to copies in the Biodiversity Heritage Library, an online repository of historical environmental science papers managed by the Smithsonian Libraries and Archives. Other sources were the National Library of Australia's Trove portal of scans of Australian historical newspapers and magazines, and a Google facsimile of the 1858 *Sydney Magazine of Science and Art*.

## PROGENITORS' PAPERS 1821–1866

Selected papers read to and/or published by members of the Philosophical Society of Australasia (1821–1822); the Agricultural Society of New South Wales (1822–1857), the Australian Philosophical Society, aka the Australian Society, (1850–1851) and the Philosophical Society of New South Wales (1856–1866). These learned societies led multi-disciplinary research in New South Wales before the Royal Society of New South Wales was inaugurated in 1866.
